

## **April Meeting**

**April 13, 2026**

The Wheeler Central Board of Education Regular Board Meeting was held April 13, 2026. Chairperson Swick called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. and pointed out the location of the Open Meetings Act poster. The roll was called with the following present: Dennis Derner, Sydney McKay, Zach Wright, Andrew Smith, Drew Kasselder, and Jessie Swick. Also present were Dan Kluver, Makayla Reiter, and Andrea Pelster.

The pledge of allegiance was recited.

Kasselder made the motion to approve the consent agenda as presented. Seconded by Wright. Roll call vote: Derner - nay, McKay - aye, Wright - aye, Smith- aye, Kasselder - aye, Swick- aye. Motion carries.

Chairperson Swick welcomed the visitors and opened the floor for public comment. No public comment was held at this time.

No Staff Report was given.

Reiter gave the Principal report.

Kluver gave the Superintendent report.

During the Board report, Swick noted the reorganization of board subcommittees. The following motions were also made during the board report.

Smith made a motion, seconded by McKay, to approve the purchase of 1 camera system from Midwest Bus for \$2815. Roll call vote: Derner - aye, McKay - aye, Wright - aye, Smith- aye, Kasselder - aye, Swick- aye. Motion carries.

Kasselder made a motion, seconded by Smith, to approve the Spring contribution of \$7500 to the CWC Athletic fund. Roll call vote: Derner - aye, McKay - aye, Wright - aye, Smith- aye, Kasselder - aye, Swick- aye. Motion carries.

Kasselder made a motion to approve the HMH quote of \$26,351.63 for Elementary Math curriculum and the HMH quote of \$1,177.90 to update the Junior High Math curriculum. Seconded by McKay. Roll call vote: Derner - aye, McKay - aye, Wright - aye, Smith- aye, Kasselder - aye, Swick- aye. Motion carries.

Smith made a motion to approve the reestablishment of Wheeler Central's FCCLA Chapter. Seconded by Kasselder. Roll call vote: Derner - aye, McKay - aye, Wright - aye, Smith- aye, Kasselder - aye, Swick- aye. Motion carries.

Kasselder made a motion to open an account at Cornerstone Bank for the QCPUF funds. All checks will require 2 signatures. Approved names on this account will include Jessica Swick, Zach Wright, Daniel Kluver, Makayla Reiter, and Andrea Pelster. This motion was seconded by McKay. Roll call vote: Derner - nay, McKay - aye, Wright - abstained, Smith- aye, Kasselder - aye, Swick- aye. Motion carries.

Kasselder made a motion to approve transfer of \$1,250,000 from the QCPUF Fund into a Certificate of Deposit at Farmers & Merchants Bank. This is a 9 month CD with a 4.37% APY. This motion was seconded by Wright. Roll call vote: Derner - nay, McKay - aye, Wright - aye, Smith- aye, Kasselder - aye, Swick- aye. Motion carries.

Kasselder made a motion to approve the invoice for \$61,568.35 to Wilkins Architecture paid out of the Special Building Fund. Seconded by Smith. Roll call vote: Derner - nay, McKay - aye, Wright - aye, Smith- aye, Kasselder - aye, Swick- aye. Motion carries.

Kasselder made a motion, seconded by McKay, to approve the mowing bid from Nordhues Family. Roll call vote: Derner - aye, McKay - aye, Wright - aye, Smith- aye, Kasselder - aye, Swick- aye. Motion carries.

Smith made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Kasselder. All in favor. Meeting adjourned at 8:58 p.m.
